

## **Sunset RV Rentals Driving With a Trailer**

1. **CLEARANCE:** The trailer height is 10' 6.5". While driving, you will be required to have an 12 foot clearance.
2. **HIGHWAY DRIVING:** Do not exceed 65 mph. Always adjust speed to weather conditions. Give yourself extra clearance when changing lanes or passing other vehicles.
3. **RIGHT-HAND TURNS:** Making right-hand turns while pulling a trailer will be different than normal. The trailer will not follow the same path as the towing vehicle — it will turn tighter than the vehicle. You will need to make a wide right-hand turn in order for the trailer to clear the curb and sidewalk.
4. **WARNINGS:** When changing lanes or turning, turn your blinker on well in advance. This will give other drivers enough warning to give you space or move out of your way.
5. **PARKING:** Always have a spotter helping you into parking spaces. If possible, find a parking space that will allow you to pull all the way through. In parking lots, it will be easier to park in an area with few vehicles, usually in the back of the parking lot.
6. **REVERSE DRIVING:** Always have a spotter to help guide you. As a general rule, if you turn the wheel to the left, the trailer will go right, and vice versa.
